Date:	Saturday 20 <sup>th</sup> May 2017
Discipline:	sprint
Event Centre:	<b>Javorník</b> – Elementary school (50.3910914N, 17.0047331E)
Parking:	Near train station. Please follow the organizer's instructions. Parking is free of charge. Distance from parking to Event centre is 1100 m. Training map (and also map with route from parking to Event centre) will be available on Saturday morning at parking, also at Event office and it is possible to download it from event webpage.
Registration:	Friday 19. 5. 18:00 – 21:00 Javorník, Elementary school Saturday 20. 5. 8:00 – 9:00 Javorník, Elementary school Extra registration is possible until the capacity of printed maps has been reached.
Bib Numbers:	for classes DH16A-DH20A + DH21E, at quarantine. All runners have to start with Bib numbers on their chest.
Changing room:	There is enough space in event centre for club tents. School hall may be used too.
Buffet:	Food and drink will be available for purchase in the event centre
Toilets:	Inside of the school building
Showers:	Shower is available inside of the school building. Showers may be used after 12:00 when quarantine is finished.
Quarantine:	The is quarantine for classes DH16A-DH20A + DH21E, competitors have to check-in to quarantine no later than 10:00. Quarantine is inside of the school building. There is enough space for warm-up. Part of quarantine is indoors. Quarantine includes toilets and drinking water. Clothes from the quarantine may be picked up after 12:00, the rest will be moved to the school hall.
GPS:	GPS vests and units will be available in the quarantine. List of runners with GPS is available on the competition website and it will also be published in the event centre and in the quarantine. Runners are obliged to carry their GPS units, otherwise they will be disqualified.
Start:	00 = 10:00, interval start Quarantine – pre-start corridor 0 m Event centre – start (for other classes) 110 m
Winning time:	According to the Czech Competition rules for Orienteering. Winning times for DH21E is 12 minutes.

- Map: Židovské schody, 1:4 000, e=2 m, A4 size  
ISSOM 2007, last revision April 2017,  
Map will be waterproof. Main cartographer and map maker is Jan Fátor.
- Terrain: city, streets, castle, chateau park
- Control description: On map and at Event Centre
- Special map symbols: black cross: bank, playground, outdoor commercial object
- Forbidden area: Any area near event centre, excluding route from parking and training map
- Punching: **SportIdent**  
If SI fails, competitors have to use backup punching system (pliers) on the map to „R“ field  
One SI card can only be used once.
- Time limit: 45 minutes
- Finish closing time: 12:45
- First Aid: Each competitor starts at his/her own responsibility. If needed, first aid will be provided in the event centre.
- Refreshment: water + syrup
- Results: Intermediate results will be available in Event centre. Official results will be published at competition webpage and in ORIS information system.
- Prize giving ceremony: 12:30
- Map return: Pick up time for competition maps is at 12:00
- Functionaries: Event director David Aleš

- Jury: list of JURY members will be published in the event centre
- Protests: For DH21E accord the IOF rules (free of charge)

- Rules: All competitors compete according to the IOF Rules, Czech Orienteering rules, Czech competition Orienteering rules and Procedure protocol for Orienteering competitions in 2017.
- Warning: Please be careful when reading your course and mind the correct order of the control points. Artificial barriers may be used in the event area. These would be marked in the map and in the terrain.  
The so called „Swiss model“ will be used for following classes: DH16A-DH20A, DH21E, H21A, H35.
